

Maame Biney Sets Eye on 2018 Olympics

A huge congratulations to KOI® speed skating alum Maame Biney, who has secured her spot on the 2018 U.S. Olympic Speedskating Team!

The Early Stages

Maame began her speedskating journey at Fort Dupont Ice Arena through our Kids On Ice® speedskating program. At the time, our longtime friend **Nathaniel Mills** and a former Olympic speedskating competitor himself, was her coach. Every Saturday morning, at the early hour of 6:30am Maame would take to the ice. Over the years she worked tirelessly; She competed in numerous races including the 500m race at the **2017 Short Track World Cup Qualifiers** where she won Gold and the **Shanghai World Cup** where she placed fifth overall.

Olympic Trials

The road to the Olympics is no easy feat. It takes a great many things including hard work and Perseverance. Even once you reach the Olympic trials, a spot is not confirmed. The first day of time trials unfortunately did not go as planned for Maame but that did not discourage her. She came back the next day and completely blew the competition out the water. Upon winning both A Finals, Maame Biney became the first African American female to qualify for the US Olympic speedskating team at the tender age of 17. It was a wonderful accomplishment and she had a lot of support at the trials, including coach Nathaniel Mills and her father Kweku Biney who held the sign, "Kick some hiney, Biney."

PyeongChang, South Korea

The 2018 PyeongChang Winter Olympics will be a first for Maame. She will be competing in the **500m and 1500m** races which begin on **February 10th, 2018**.

We are so proud of you Maame and we know this is only the beginning.
