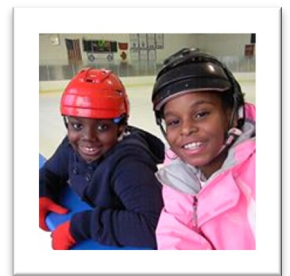

## Getting started!

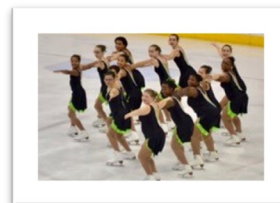
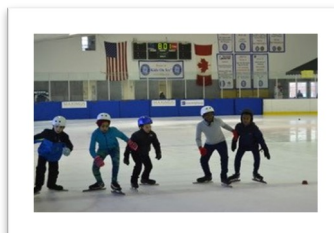
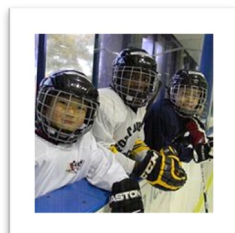
