



2019 Kids On Ice PLUS Synchronized Skating

July 13- Dec 21, 2019

Prerequisite: Passed Basic 5

The Kids On Ice PLUS Synchro program is designed to offer an introduction to synchronized skating in a fun and structured atmosphere. The KOI PLUS Synchro season will run from July to December, beginning with an Open House and week-long camp and culminating with our annual Holiday Show.

JOIN US FOR OUR OPEN HOUSE on July 13, 2019!

The 2019 season will kick off with an Open House and skills assessment. This session is a chance for prospective members to try out synchronized skating. It is also an opportunity for returning skaters to demonstrate their skills.

- **Open House Session A at 11:00am: Age 12+ or passed Free Skate 1**
- **Open House Session B at 12:00pm: Age 12 and under and passed Basic 5**

Skaters who have passed Basic 3 or 4 are invited to participate in the Synchro Badge program (only) during our 8-week LTS sessions, when available. Details TBA.

SYNCHRO CAMP Jul 15, 2019 to July 19, 2019 8:30am-5:00pm

At our week-long summer camp skaters will learn program choreography, work on developing skills, and participate in fun team building activities.

PRACTICES & PERFORMANCES

The program will offer up to four tiers of participation based on the number of skaters enrolled, skill levels, and ages. The number of practices, performances, and competition opportunities increase from the first tier to the top tier. Practices will begin immediately following Synchro camp in July, except for the Intro level, which will begin practice in September. **As with all PLUS programs, skaters are expected to commit to full attendance and participation.**

Important Dates:

- **Monday July 22, 7:25pm:** Parent meeting & first practice (except Intro level team)
- **July-August:** Practice Mon and/or Wed evenings (except Intro level team)
- **September-December:**
 - Advanced team will practice Sunday mornings
 - All other teams will practice Saturday mornings
 - The new Learn to Skate USA Badge program for synchro, when available, will take place on Saturday mornings during our 8-week LTS sessions for skaters who have passed Basic 3 or 4

PROGRAM FEES

Fees will vary based on team placement. **All skaters will pay a \$150 deposit before their first ice session.** The deposit will be credited toward the team fee. Scholarship opportunities will be available.

SKATER DEVELOPMENT

It is our hope that the KOI PLUS Synchro program will prepare skaters to excel in synchronized skating beyond our introductory program. Skaters who are seeking to advance to competitive level opportunities are encouraged to graduate to other local synchro programs.
